Texas A&M hopes to bolster its College Football Playoff chances, while Auburn aims to play spoiler in a key SEC West Division clash on Saturday. The Aggies ranked fifth in the second edition of the CFB Playoff rankings on Tuesday, and while coach Jimbo Fisher's team needs some help to make the four-team postseason, a road win against the Tigers would certainly bolster the resume. On the other sideline, Auburn is coming off a loss to Alabama and needs to win one of its two remaining regular-season games to secure a winning record.

After a two-week gap in games due to COVID-19 issues, Texas A&M knocked off the rust in a 20-7 win against LSU last Saturday. However, the victory was far from perfect. Fisher's offense averaged only 3.8 yards per play, did not have a completion longer than 18 yards and no drive in the second half went beyond 28 yards. While weather issues and rust played a role in the sluggish performance, Texas A&M knows it has to play better to have a shot at the four-team playoff. Prior to the two-week absence on the gridiron, Fisher's team was hitting on all cylinders. After losing to Alabama, the Aggies beat Florida 41-38 and proceeded to beat Mississippi State, Arkansas, South Carolina, and LSU by 11 or more points.
